Fundations® is a multisensory and systematic phonics, spelling, and handwriting program that benefits K-3 students in a Tier 1 or Tier 2 setting. Fundations thoroughly teaches the foundational reading skills found in states' rigorous college- and career-ready standards, including the Common Core State Standards (print concepts, phonological awareness, fluency, phonics and word recognition). It also strongly supports the writing and language standards, providing mastery instruction for many of the goals in each of those areas. The power of Fundations is that it incorporates the science of reading and writing in a carefully designed, multisensory, and highly integrated manner.

Each Fundations Level-specific workshop provides the practice and guidance needed to effectively begin teaching the Fundations curriculum for the designated grade level(s).

At the completion of the workshop, participants will be able to:

- Understand the research base of the Fundations program and the why and how of Fundations instruction.
- Identify the skills taught in the specific Fundations Level in the following areas: phonemic awareness, phonics and word study, vocabulary, high frequency/trick words, fluency, comprehension, handwriting, spelling, and punctuation.
- Understand the principles of instruction: explicit, sequential and cumulative, engaging multiple learning modalities with multisensory techniques, repetition, and feedback.
- Prepare a daily learning plan and practice lesson activity procedures.
- Build a learning-focused classroom that maximizes instructional time.
