
All coursework and practicums follow the curriculum set forth by the Orton-Gillingham Academy.

- Subsequent Associate Practicum available at an additional cost with ongoing, individualized guidance. Bachelor's degree required. Both coursework and practicum are required to apply for Associate Certification by OGA.
- 3 GTRE Credits available through CU Boulder for an additional fee.
